



Who Do You Trust? Proverbs 3:5-6

Why should we trust God?

I. God demands our faith.

Trust in the Lord with all your heart. – Vs 5

- Webster defines trust: Belief that someone or something is reliable, honest, effective.
- Trust in this passage means to put all of your weight.
- When you put your trust in God, you put all your weight on Him.
- Trusting in God with all your heart simply means just letting go.
- In your heart you have to answer the question: Is God trustworthy?
- Are YOU willing to let God guide your life?

II. God defines our focus.

And lean not on your own understanding. – Vs. 5

- When you lean on your understanding you lose focus.
- Our own understanding is limited, fallible, and subject to error.
- Leaning on the Lord is the best thing to do, why?
 - ✓ God knows all things better than we do. James 1:5-8
 - ✓ God can do all things, and He is not limited as we are. Mark 9:23
 - ✓ God is dependable and trustworthy. Psalms 37:3-6
 - ✓ God has the best plans and will do it in His ways and at His time. Jeremiah 29:11

III. God determines our future.

In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy path. – Vs. 6

- Acknowledge Him means to see Him.
- In everything we need to look for His guidance.
- When we do our part, by bring things to Him, He will do His, which is directing your path.
