



What Are You Building Your Life On? Matthew 7:24-27

- I. Anchor the hope of your life on the thing that will last forever**
 - Matt. 24:35; 2 Cor. 5:1; Heb. 6:19
 - When you are anchored in Christ, He will be able to still the storm in your life.
- II. Build your foundation on the thing that will never be shaken**
 - A house is only as strong as its foundation. I Cor. 3:11; Heb. 12:27
- III. Expect that the storms of life are unavoidable**
 - Our faith will be tested.
 - A faith that cannot be tested is a faith that can not be trusted. I Cor. 10:13
- IV. Don't settle for anything less and temporary**
 - When we build our lives on the words of men versus the Word of God, our life will not be able to withstand the storms of life. Matt. 15:8-9
- V. Cling on the promise of God's love even in the darkest period of time**
 - If our faith is grounded below the baseline into the bedrock of Christ, our life will be proven to withstand the toughest of situations.
 - What is the foundation that your life is being built upon?
 - There is only one foundation: Jesus. Acts 4:11-12
 - We can make it through life's toughest seasons when we focus on Christ as our foundation. Heb. 12:1-2
 - Don't let anything separate you from Christ. Rom. 8:35-39
