Psalm 112:1-10

Psalm 112 is a passage that was written by a man for men. What can we learn:

Be a man who fears God and finds great delight in His commands. Vs 1

- When a man truly fears God and truly loves God's word, his life is going to be productive and successful. How?
- There is a promise concerning his children. Vs 2
- There is a promise concerning his character. Vs 3-4
- There is a promise concerning his conduct. Vs 5
- There is a promise concerning his confidence. Vs 6-8
- There is a promise concerning his charity. Vs 9
- There is a promise concerning his commendation. Vs 6, 9

Acknowledge the power of your influence

- As a husband you have a powerful influence upon your wife. Eph. 5:24-25
- As a father you have a powerful influence on your children
- Psa. 112:1-2; 127:3-5; Prov. 13:24; Eph. 6:4; Col. 3:21
- Children often follow the same paths taken by their father whether it be for evil or good.
- In the Bible some followed the righteous example of Godly fathers. 2 Chron. 17:3; 26:4
- Some followed the godless and sinful examples their fathers had set. 1 King 22:52; Jer. 9:14
- If you fail to live and act in a godly way, you will pass that cycle of sin on to your children. Ex.20:5

Arrange the priorities of your life

- Man's first priority must be to God. Psa. 112:1; Rev. 2:4; Matt. 6:33
- Man must make a priority of his family. Psa. 112:2
- Man must make a priority of developing inner character and personal righteousness. Psa. 112:2-9
