We are supposed to be unified.

- Doesn't mean that we have to agree on everything
- Doesn't mean we have the same gifts, talents, and skills

What is our calling?

When we are called by God;

- We answer the call to live a life that is worthy of His calling.
- Our conduct should be such that it brings honor to Christ in all that we do.

Attitudes we need to display.

- Lowliness: - don't think too highly of yourself.
- Meekness: - strength under control.
- Longsuffering: - having a long fuse with other people
- Forbearing: - you and I to put up with each other.
- Love: - whatever we do, we must do it with a spirit of love. - Col. 3:14
- Endeavouring: - to make every effort
- To keep the unity: - unity is not uniformity;
 - ✓ it is not being the same or thinking the same
 - ✓ it concerns gathering around the same things and being bound together because of them.

Seven things that MUST unify every person who is a Christian.

1. One body
2. One Spirit
3. One hope of our calling - 2 Corinthians 15:55
4. One Lord
5. One faith
6. One baptism - Rom. 6:3, 4
7. One God and Father
 - ✓ Overall (in authority over us)
 - ✓ Through all (ministering through us)
 - ✓ In all (residing in all of us)
 - ✓ He is the One who brings us together.
