- Is this the direction the Bible says I should go?

Keep Right:



- Is my choice honest?
- Would I want others to know that I am going down this path?
- Another word for honesty is integrity. Prov. 10:9,10; James 4:17; Gal. 6:7

Under Construction:



- Will this decision, will this direction build me up or tear me down? Will it make me a better person?
- Will that decision really improve your life? I Cor. 10:23

No Exit:



- "Is there a way out?" If I follow this direction is there a way out? Will this decision put me into a position where I'm bound? I Cor. 6:12
- Question: Could this decision lead to addiction?

Sightseeing:



- What will others do when they see me? Will what I'm doing hurt someone else?
